You have been given this pamphlet because your pregnancy may be at risk. We know this is a very difficult time for you. The information in this pamphlet is not meant to replace the medical advice of your care providers but to help you understand what may happen in the next few days and weeks. Please take a few minutes to read the information before your clinic appointment.



Early Pregnancy Assessment Clinic

You have been referred to the clinic because your pregnancy may be at risk, requiring specialized care by a gynecologist.

The clinic operates weekly on Tuesday and Friday morning.

Appointments are by referral only. If you were seen in the Emergency Department, they will FAX a referral on your behalf to the EPAU clinic.

Referrals are reviewed by the gynecologist the day before clinic. We will contact you with the date and time of your appointment once the referral has been accepted.

What may happen at your visit?

Appointments are in person at the hospital. In special circumstances, the appointment may be held over the telephone. You will speak with a Registered nurse as well as a gynecologist about your care.

Prior to your appointment, you may have tests such as blood work and an ultrasound to determine if your pregnancy is at risk. The doctor will discuss these results with you and recommended treatment plan.

If your pregnancy is ending, you may be treated with medications or have an outpatient surgical procedure performed called a dilation & curettage (D & C).

Translation services are available for those patients who require this option. Please let the booking secretary know the preferred language at the time of appointment booking.

To get to the clinic

 Enter the hospital at the KW Site's main entrance (3rd Floor). A-wing is immediately to the right of the front lobby. Any of our hospital volunteers will help you find your way.

If you require a surgical procedure:

- Have a list of any medications that you are taking
- Your health card;

- □ A family member or friend for support, if possible. If you have a D & C, you MUST have someone drive you home. You may not take the bus or drive yourself. You must have someone at home with you for the first 24 hours.
