How to Sign-Up for Rides to Cancer Appointments

Wheels of Hope (WoH) is a volunteer driver service run by the Canadian Cancer Society. They book volunteer drivers to pick you up and drop you off at cancer appointments. This can be for:

- Oncologist (cancer doctor) appointments
- Medical Imaging appointments (like an X-ray or CT scan)
- Cancer Treatments

Signing-Up:

- Talk to your cancer healthcare team; they will send a **referral for you**.
- Canadian Cancer Society (CCS) agent will call you within 1-2 business days.
- Each rider must pay a \$100 registration fee to sign up. This will cover **1 year of rides no matter how many you need**. Ask your CCS agent about support options if you are not able to pay this fee.

Booking Your Ride:

1. Call the Canadian Cancer Society: **1-888-939-3333**
2. Book your ride at least **3** business days ahead.
3. Ask the CCS agent about online booking options.

Changing Your Ride:

To cancel or change rides you **must call the Canadian Cancer Society**. They plan all ride bookings.
